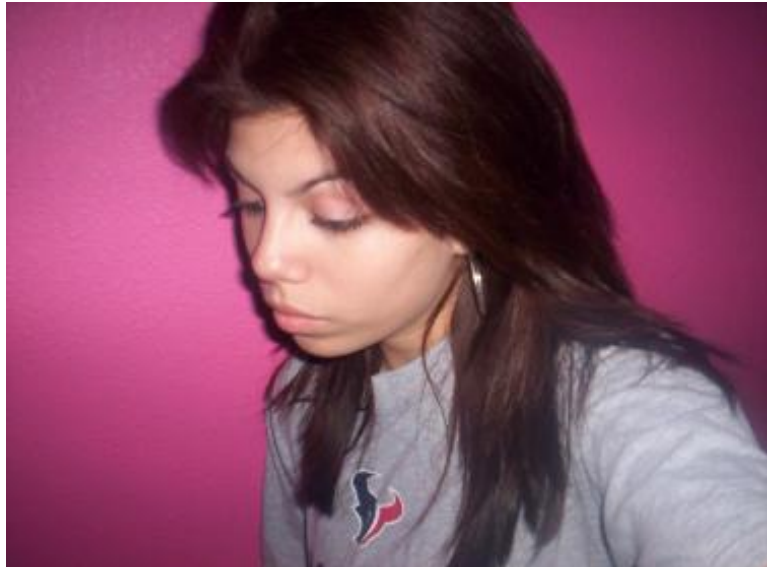




PAULA DEANDA

Paula's big break came when she auditioned for Clive Davis which led immediately to her signing a major label contract with Arista.
